Record Investment in Local Health



No State Government in Australia invests more in healthcare per person than the Cook Labor Government.

This record investment means more beds in our hospitals, more nurses and doctors, and reforms to ease pressure on our emergency departments.

In the last two years, the State Government has delivered 30 new beds at our local Rockingham General Hospital, and opened the new Women's Outpatient Clinic as a 'one stop shop' for women's services in the Rockingham area.

Cost of Living Relief

Cost of living is a real concern for many families across our community.

The Cook Labor Government is committed to providing support and relief from cost of living pressures.

Every household in WA will receive two electricity credits on their power bills this year, totalling \$400.

The first \$200 credit has been applied to bills that were issued since the 1st of July, and the second \$200 credit will be provided in December to make life a little easier for households over the Christmas period.
